We warmly welcome you to visit our tea garden in Angus, located in a beautiful setting on our working family farm approximately 10 miles north of Dundee.

We produce limited quantities of Scotland's first ever 100% pure black tea Kinnettles Gold. This is hand-rolled from leaf plucked from our 13 year old bushes growing in polytunnels. In 2016 we rejuvenated our old walled garden by planting 4,000 Nepali tea seedlings that are producing small quantities of tea now the plants have matured. This leaf is contributed to Nine Ladies Dancing, our Tea Gardens of Scotland black tea sold in Fortnum and Mason. A further half-acre of Georgian seedling tea was planted 3 years ago and will come into bearing in 2024.

Our tours are on Wednesdays from 10.00am - midday and 2.00pm - 4.00pm. The cost is £45.00 per person and the tour will take 2 hours. You will see our tea project, be shown and try your hand at plucking tea, see how the tea is processed and learn about our Tea Gardens of Scotland project. There is also a tea tasting.
